

Funding for the Plan NH Scholarship and Fellowship program comes from these funds, managed by the NH Charitable Foundation:

- **Alfred T. Granger Student Art Trust Fund:** awards undergraduate or graduate students pursuing careers in:
 - Architecture
 - Certain Engineering Disciplines impacting the *Built Environment*
 - Interior Design
 - Studio Arts
- **Paul and Ann Harvey Scholarship Fund for Manchester:** providing scholarship funds for students living in the greater Manchester area* who exhibit financial need, in order to permit them to attend accredited post-secondary institutions (2-4 year colleges, universities, technical/trade/vocational schools) with a preference for those interested in architecture, engineering and/or a construction-related field or trade.

** Qualifying towns include Allenstown, Amherst, Auburn, Bedford, Candia, Chester, Deerfield, Derry, Dunbarton, Epping, Fremont, Goffstown, Hampstead, Hooksett, Litchfield, Londonderry, Manchester, Merrimack, Mont Vernon, New Boston, Raymond, Sandown, Suncook, Weare and Windham.*

- **Oscar L. Vaughan Scholarship Fund:** providing assistance to graduate students or upperclassmen interested in becoming a certified architect. Preference made for students from Portsmouth or Seacoast NH.
- **Oscar Neukom Scholarship Fund:** providing assistance to graduate students studying science or engineering. This fund is for students who are graduates of Portsmouth High School. Preference shall be given to students who aspire to enter the fields of law, medicine, science or engineering.
- **Erika Tardif Scholarship Fund for Science and Math:** The purpose of this fund is to provide scholarship assistance to NH students pursuing undergraduate or graduate studies in science and mathematics, including but not limited to chemistry, physics or math.
- **Plan New Hampshire Scholarship Fund:** providing funding for undergraduates studying a field related to the Plan NH mission.
